The Common Fisheries Policy - The Basse Normandie, second French region by its coast kilometers, third region in terms of fisheries volume and first French region for shell fishing is strongly involved in the European debate of the future of this policy. The region has responded to the Commission Paper on the reform of the common fisheries policy. This workshop aims to share, with the speakers, European and local issues such as: fleet capacity, sustainable fishing, respect of rules, quotas...

Agriculture: The future of the milk sector - Last year debates illustrated the difficulties that the milk producers have to face in Basse-Normandie. While the EU is reforming the Common Agriculture Policy, it is important to discuss the public mechanisms of market regulation and the quotas.
